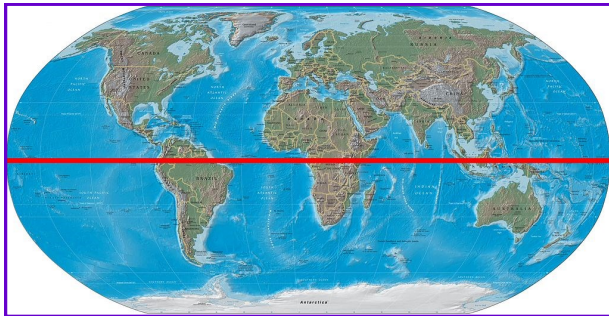

Glossary

- Africa** A continent south of Europe and between the Atlantic and Indian Ocean.
- canoe** A light, narrow boat with pointed ends and no keel, propelled with a paddle or paddles.
- continent** One of the seven large land masses on the Earth's surface, surrounded or mainly surrounded by sea.
- crops** Plants that are grown to be used or sold (such as rice, corn or fruit).
- farm** An area of land and its buildings, used for growing crops and rearing animals.
- Lusaka City** Capital of Zambia.
- population** The number of people living in a place.
- market stall** A stand or booth where goods are sold in a market.
- River Zambezi** The Zambezi is the fourth-longest river in Africa, the longest east-flowing river in Africa and the largest flowing into the Indian Ocean from Africa.
- rural** A characteristic of the countryside, rather than a town.
- savanna** A grassy plain in tropical and sub-tropical regions.
- Victoria Falls** A waterfall on the Zambezi River in southern Africa, which provides habitat for plants and animals.
- waterfall** A cascade of water from a height.
- wildlife** The wild animals and plants in an area.
- Zambia** A country in southern Africa.
