Where does this learning link to aspirations for the future?

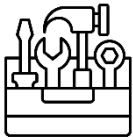
Flying Colours flag makers make the Royal flags as well as many others. There are lots of companies that make flags and banners that need designers.

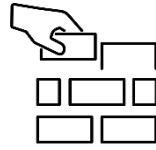

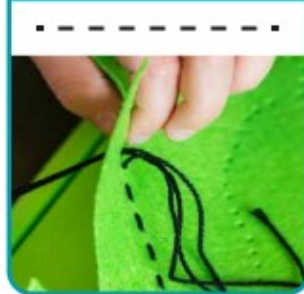

Glossary

accurate

Neat and correct, with the right shape, size, pattern and with no mistakes.

applique

A type of textile art where small pieces of cloth are sewn or glued onto a larger piece to make a design.

embellish

To add decorative details or features to something.

fabric

A natural or man-made woven or knitted material that is made from plant fibres, animal fur or synthetic material.

patch

A piece of fabric sewn onto a larger piece, sometimes for decoration and sometimes to cover a hole in the material underneath.

running stitch

A basic sewing stitch made in a straight line with spaces between stitches.

seam

The line where two pieces of fabric are sewn together.

template

A tool used to make copies of a shape or to cut a material accurately, such as a biscuit cutter.



Remember to tie a know in the thread so that the stitches stay secure and do not come undone!
