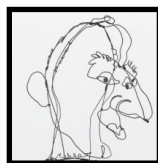

abstract



Making art that doesn't look like a real-life object, but uses colours, shapes and lines to create something interesting.

continuous line



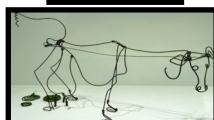
Continuous line drawings are made by keeping the pen or pencil in contact with the paper until completed.

contour



The outline of a shape or object.

form



When art is three-dimensional, it has height, width and depth.

manipulate



Involves bending, twisting and coiling to create 3D forms.



Alexander Calder was an American artist who was known for creating mobile. These were kinetic sculptures, meaning they had pieces that moved.

He was greatly inspired by animals and the circus.
