

Attendance & Support Survey – One-Page Summary Report

This report summarises key findings from the St Dennis Primary Academy Attendance & Support Survey.

Key Findings

- 28 total responses across Nursery–Year 6.
- 71.4% reported very good attendance; 25% mostly good; 3.6% some absences.
- Main barriers: illness/medical needs, weather/travel, anxiety/worry, working patterns, morning routines.

Walking Bus Pilot

- 14.3% Yes, 32.1% Maybe, 53.6% No.
- Highest interest days: Wednesday and Friday.
- Most common suggested start time: 8:30am.
- Frequently suggested pick-up points: Robartes Road, St Dennis Doctors, Trelavour Square/Kays, Wellington Road, Kellow Road.

Breakfast Club

- 25% would use regularly; 17.9% occasionally.
- Preferred start times: 7:45am, 7:30am, 8:00am.
- Most encouraging factors: help with getting to work on time, affordable cost, free/subsidised places.

Recommendations

- Trial Walking Bus on Wed or Fri at 8:30am with 2–3 initial pick-up points.
- Adjust Breakfast Club start time to 7:45am with clear booking information.
- Provide targeted support to families highlighting anxiety/routine challenges.
- Issue parent update summarising pilot details and improvements.
