

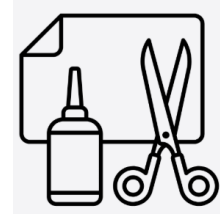

Amy is particularly inspired by the endless variations in nature. Her pieces are created using a variety of techniques and processes such as firing, hand stencilling and sandblasting.

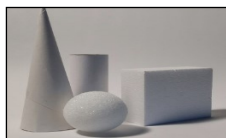
Glossary

ceramics



Object made from natural materials, like clay, that are shaped and then hardened usually in a kiln.

form



A 3D shape.

score



A roughened textured surface created by scratching a piece of clay.

slab



A flat, uniformly rolled out sheet of clay.

slip



A liquid mixture of clay and water used as glue to join pieces of clay together.
