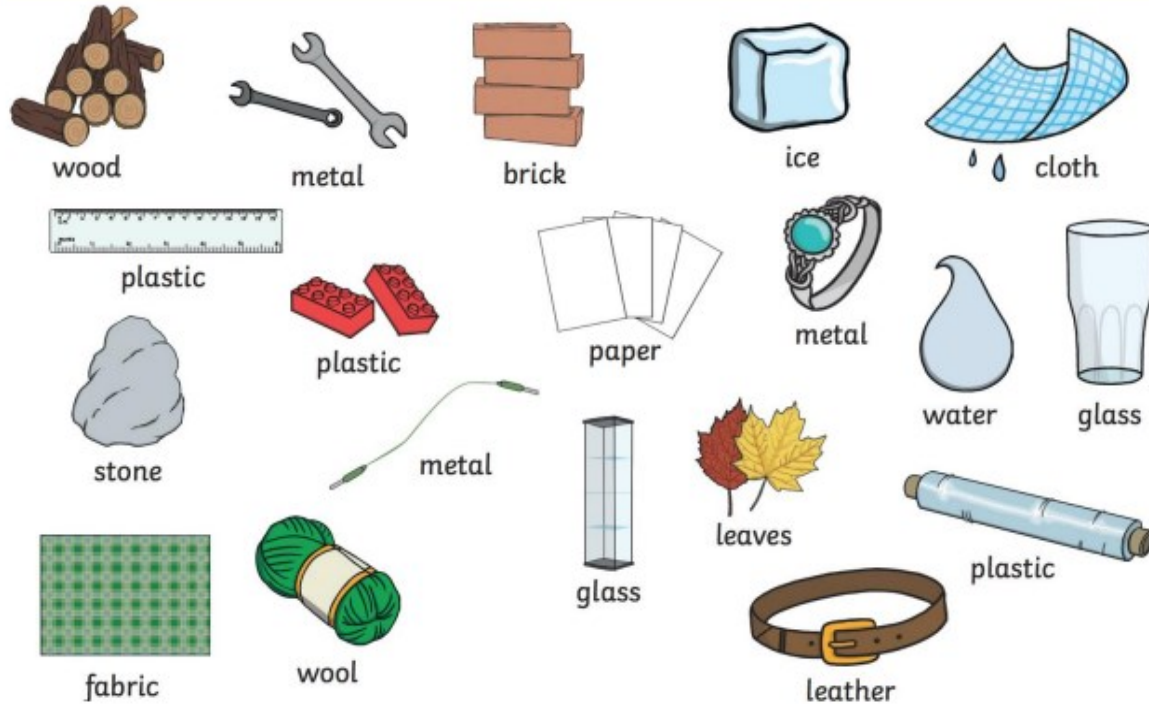

Glossary

absorbent	When water is soaked up by a material
bumpy	Covered in bumps
dull	Not bright or shiny
fabric	A cloth made by knitting or weaving fibres
glass	A solid transparent material
hard	Not easily broken or bent.
materials	What an object is made out of.
metal	A solid material such as aluminium, iron and silver
plastic	A material made by people that can be formed into any shape
rock	Natural material from the Earth
rough	Feels and looks bumpy.
rubber	Strong, elastic material used in tyres and boots
smooth	Has no lumps or bumps.
soft	Easy to cut, fold or change the shape of.
stretchy	Can be pulled to make it longer or wider without it breaking.
waterproof	When water does not soak through a material and runs off
wood	Hard material from trees and shrubs
