### Glossary

- climate** The general weather conditions that are typical of a place.
- desert** A large area of land, usually in a hot region, where there is almost no water, rain or vegetation.
- environment** The physical surrounding in Earth.
- habitat** The place in which a living thing lives.
- rainfall** The amount of rain that falls in a certain time period.
- temperate** A place which is never extremely hot or extremely cold.
- tropical** The tropics have a humid climate, where the weather is hot and damp. They are near the Equator.



### Key Facts

- The Equator is an invisible line that runs around the centre of the Earth.
- The North and South Poles are the places furthest away from the Equator.
- A place is usually hot if it is near the Equator.
- A place is usually cold if it is near the North or South Pole.
