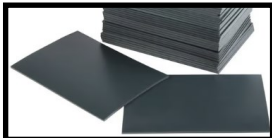
Glossary

etching



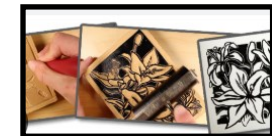
A printing technique where an image is created by using a sharp tool to remove a layer.

lino (linoleum)



A soft, smooth and flexible material using for creating a printing plate.

lino print



A form of relief printing.

relief print



A printing method where a raised surface is covered in ink and pressed onto paper to create a print.

Ukiyo-e



A famous style of Japanese art.
