Henri Rousseau was a French self-taught painter known for his jungle scenes painted with meticulous detail and vibrant colours.

His inspiration came from visits to botanical gardens, zoos and illustrated books. His primary medium was oil on canvas using thin, precise brushstrokes to create patterns in foliage and textures.

background



The part of the picture that appears furthest away from the viewer.

composition



How an artist arranges the different parts within a picture.

foreground



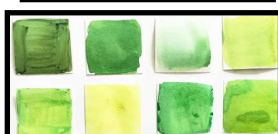
The part of the picture that appears closest to the viewer.

scale



The size of an artwork or objects within it.

shades



A shade is created by adding black to a colour to make it darker.
