Glossary	
<p>colour</p>	<p>Colour is seen by the way colour reflects off a surface.</p>
<p>line</p>	<p>Line is the path of a moving point. Lines define the edges of shapes and forms</p>
<p>primary colours</p>	<p>There are three primary colours. These are pure colours which cannot be made by mixing other</p>
<p>secondary colours</p>	<p>Secondary colours are made by mixing each primary colour with one other primary colour.</p>
<p>Shape and form</p>	<p>Shape and form are areas enclosed by line.</p>
<p>Friedensreich Hunderwasser</p>	<p>He was an Austrian visual artist and architect and also worked for environmental protection. 1928-2000</p>
<p>Piet Mondrian</p>	<p>He was a Dutch abstract artist who was most famous for using shape in his paintings. 1872-1944.</p>
