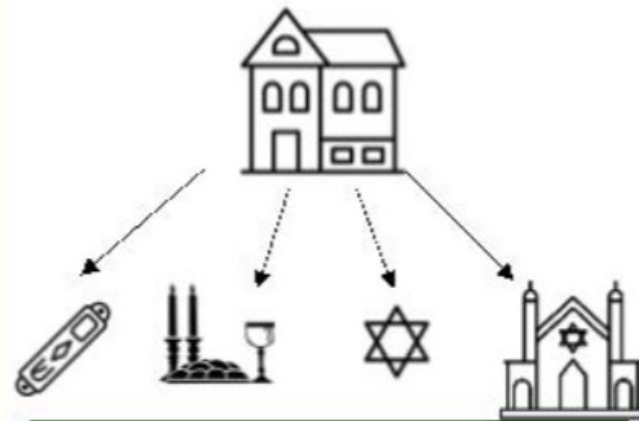

## Glossary

Chanukah	A Jewish festival.
dreidel	A four-sided spinning top.
God	All powerful being who Jewish people believe created the world.
Jewish	Relating to the religion of Judaism.
mezuzah	A small scroll with words from the Torah written on it.
Shabbat	A day of rest for Jewish people.
Shema	A Jewish prayer.
Star of David	The symbol of Judaism.
Synagogue	A place of worship for Jewish people.
Torah	The Jewish holy book.

Some Jewish people keep **Shabbat** when they will not work or travel and have a special meal to remember the day God rested when he created the world.

**Chanukah** is a festival which helps Jewish people remember when there was only enough oil to keep the temple menorah lit for one day but it stayed alight for eight days.

Some of these stories are in the **Torah** such as the story of David and Goliath.
