Glossary	
<p>drawing</p>	<p>The 5 basic skills of drawing are understanding edges, spaces, light and shadow, relationships, and, the whole, or gestalt.</p>
<p>Impressionism</p>	<p>Impressionist artists use thin, small brush strokes in their paintings Some of the main characteristics of this style were quick brushstrokes and a focus on the light in a scene.</p>
<p>shape and form</p> <p>Shape: An enclosed space defined by other art elements such as line, color and texture.</p>	<p>Form is considered 3 dimensional showing height, width and depth. Shapes have two dimensions and are usually defined by lines. They can be organic or geometric.</p>
<p>value</p>	<p>Value, sometimes known as tone, shows a range of lights to darks and a contrast between light and dark.</p>
<p>What is "Space art"?</p>	<p>"Space art" is the term for a genre of modern artistic expression that strives to show the wonders of the Universe.</p>
<p>Vincent van Gogh</p>	<p>Vincent Willem van Gogh was a Dutch Post-Impressionist painter who, after he died, became one of the most famous and influential figures in Western art history. In a decade, he created about 2,100 artworks, including around 860 oil paintings, most of which date from the last two years of his life.</p>
