# La fecha

**phonics**

sound in:

- domingo
- agosto

**accents** Accents indicate the vowel is stressed. As seen in the words sábado and miércoles.

**ñ tilde** This changes the 'n' to a 'ny' sound like in the English word 'onion'. As in the Spanish word cumpleaños.

**stress placement** Words that end in a vowel, 'n' or 's' are normally stressed on the second to last syllable. Like sep-tiem-bre, ju-lío and trein-ta.

**¿Cuándo es tu cumpleaños?** *When is your birthday?*

Days of the week and months of the year do not have capital letters unless they are at the start of a sentence in Spanish.

**Hoy es lunes ocho de julio.**

*Today it is Monday the the eighth of July.*

No capital letter in the phrase above for the day of the week 'Monday' or the month 'July' in Spanish.
