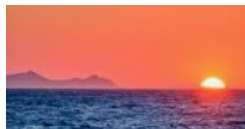

Glossary

horizon



The horizontal line where the sky appears to meet the land or sea.

industrial landscape



A landscape painting or drawing that shows scenes including factories, chimneys and cities.

one-point perspective



A technique in art that uses a vanishing point to make flat drawings appear three-dimensional.

proportion



Objects in the landscape have sizes that make sense in relation to each other.

vanishing point



A spot on the horizon where parallel lines meet creating an illusion that the picture is 3D.



LS Lowry was a famous English artist who is well-known for his painting and drawings of everyday life in industrial areas.

His landscape paintings often showed many tiny human figures known as matchstick men. When drawing, he used a limited palette of colours and sketched his outlines in pencil or charcoal.
