Glossary

coiling



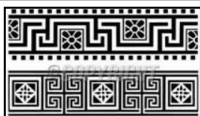
Hand rolling long coils of clay and layering them using slip, and scoring to build a form.

form



When art is three-dimensional, it has height, width and depth.

motif



An image, symbol or element which repeats across the artwork.

score



A roughened textured surface, created by scratching a piece of clay.

slip



A liquid mixture of clay and water used as glue to join pieces of clay together.



Ancient Greek vases are renowned for their detailed, storytelling illustrations. They were primarily produced in the style of black silhouettes on red clay with details added by scratching or incisions. The vases often depicted mythology, daily life and athletes.
