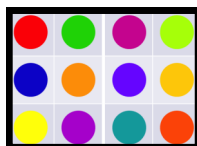

Glossary

contrasting colours



Colours that sit across from each other on the colour wheel.

illustration



Art that tells a story, explains an idea or decorates text.

monochrome



A style of art that only uses one colour plus black and white in the whole composition.

surrealism



Art about dreams, strange ideas and things that don't usually belong together.

symbolism



Using objects, colours or images to represent bigger ideas or feelings.



Anthony Browne is a well-known writer and illustrator known for his unique, surreal art style and frequent use of gorillas.

His illustrations often include hidden details or strange, dream-like objects. The colours and objects used often symbolise a character's feelings.
