Glossary

abstract



Making art that doesn't look like a real-life object but uses colours, shapes and lines to create something interesting.

colour



The way an object is described, based on the way it reflects light.

composition



The way an artist arranges the parts of their picture to make it look good.

Fauvism



An art style where artists use bright, unrealistic colours to show how they feel. not just how it looks.

shape



A two-dimensional shape enclosed by a line.
