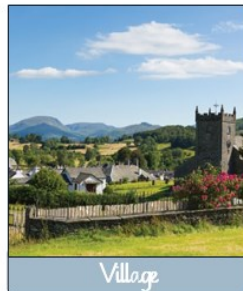


### physical features



**Settlements** are places where people live sometimes work. They can be small or large depending on how many people live or work there.

There are three types of settlements: villages, towns and cities.



### Glossary

- beach A strip of land covered with sand, shingle or small stones.
- coast The part of the land that joins the sea.
- ocean An area of sea.
- pebble A small stone made smooth by sand or action of the sea.
- port A docking place for ships on the coast of an ocean.
- rockpool Small pools of sea water that form along the coastline and are a habitat for sea creatures.
- sand Loose fragments of minerals and rocks.
- settlement A place where people live and sometimes work.
- ship A large boat for transporting people or goods by sea.
- shop A place where goods or services are sold.
- shore The land bordering the ocean.
- town A settlement that is larger than a village and smaller than a city.
- village A small settlement usually found in a rural setting.
- waves A long body of water curling into an arched form.
