architect



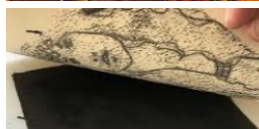
A person who plans and design buildings and other structures.

monoprint



A printing technique where the image can only be printed once.

pressure



Pressing down firmly on the paper to help the image transfer from the surface.

repeated

pattern



A pattern that repeats itself.
