Georgia O'Keefe was an American artist famous for her giant, colourful close-up pictures of flowers.

She mostly used oil paints as they allowed for vibrant colours and smooth blending. She would zoom in on a small section of the flower and enlarge it until it filled a canvas.

Glossary

close-up



Zooming in on a part of an object and looking at it very closely.

etch



Where a design is created by scratching lines into clay.

pattern



Where a design is created by repeating lines, shapes, forms or colours

slab



Flat evenly rolled out sheet of clay.

texture



The way something feels.
