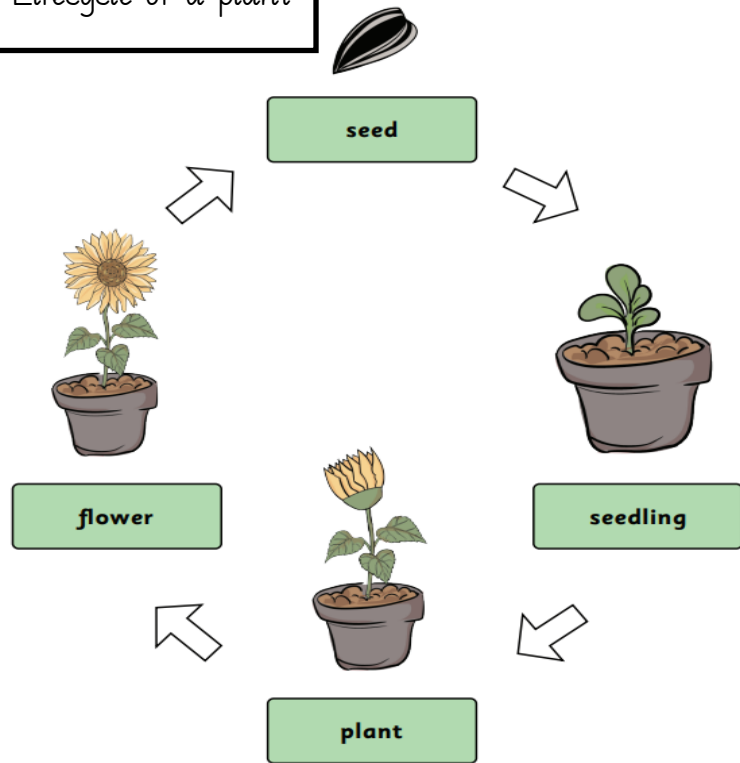

The plants we eat are called **fruits and vegetables**. Fruit and vegetables grow in the same way as other plants.

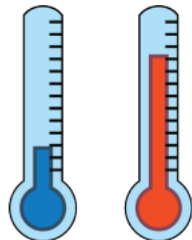
Herbs are also plants.



Glossary

- bulb** A fleshy base of a plant that can grow another plant.
- flower** The seed bearing part of a plant that is usually surrounded by brightly coloured petals.
- leaf** Part of a plant that is typically flat and hangs off the stem
- plant** A plant is a living organism.
- roots** the part of the plant that attaches into the ground for support and nutrient collection.
- seed** A small part of a plant that can grow another plant.
- stem** The stem holds the plant up and carries the water and nutrients from the roots to the leaves and flowers.
- tree** A woody plant.

Plants need certain things to grow and be healthy.



- Water
- Sunlight
- The right temperature

We use **seeds** to grow new plants. New seeds grow as part of the plant.

Seeds can be found inside some fruits.
