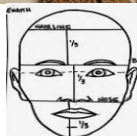
Glossary

portrait



A piece of artwork that show a person which can be a drawing, painting or photograph.

proportion



How big or small one part of a picture is compared to other parts of the picture.

realism



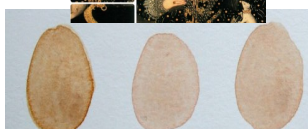
When an artist draws things with correct proportions and the artwork looks real.

symbolism



Tudor portraits used specific symbols in paintings to show important things about the person.

tint



A tint is a lighter version of the colour created by mixing it with white.



Hans Holbein was a German artist who painted realistic portraits of King Henry VIII.

His portraits used objects to show symbolism like wealth, power and purity. He used multi-layers in his portraits and focused on the facial details.
