### Forever Facts

Henry VIII was King of England 1509-1547.

The  **Battle of Bosworth**  took place in 1485 to begin the Tudor era. The battle was fought between the  **House of Lancaster and the House of Tudor**  led by Henry VIII. This took place to see which house would take to the throne of Britain.

Henry VIII broke from Rome in 1528 and created the  **Church of England** . He did this because the Pope opposed his decision to divorce from Catherine of Aragon. The Church of England was then created so that Henry VIII could do this.

Henry VIII didn't just want power—he made big changes that gave England its own church, helped people understand religion in English, and created new chances for families to own land. His reign was a turning point that made Britain stronger and different from before.

| <b>Act of Supremacy</b>               | A law that declared King Henry VIII the Supreme Head of the Church of England.                       |
| <b>Battle of Bosworth</b>             | The battle that marked the end of the War of the Roses.  |

| <b>dissolution of the monasteries</b> | When Henry VIII closed down Catholic abbeys, monasteries and convents in England, Wales and Ireland. |
