Elements of Art

Line

Shape & Form
 Circle, Triangle, Square, Rectangle, Oval, Sphere, Pyramid, Cube, Cylinder, Cone, Prism, Oval, Sphere, Cone, Cylinder, Pyramid, Cube, Rectangle, Triangle, Square, Circle

Color
 Cool Colors (Blue, Green, Purple), Warm Colors (Red, Orange, Yellow), Neutral Tints, Neutral Shades

Texture
 Smooth, Rough, Hard, Soft, Bumpy, Jagged, Wavy

Space
 Smaller in the distance, Filled the white paper, Shows Perspective, Overlapping shapes

Value
 Shading, Range of light to dark, Contrast - light against dark

- By the end of this unit you will be able to:

 - Create and combine shapes of recognisable form to produce a beaded necklace.

<p>Glossary</p>	
<p>Chalks and charcoals</p>	<p>Charcoal is a black crumbly drawing material made of carbon and often used for sketching and under-drawing for paintings.</p>
<p>Lascaux</p>	<p>Lascaux is a network of caves near the village of Montignac, in southwestern France.</p>
<p>limited colour palette</p>	<p>Using a limited palette means that you're only using a few select colours in your piece of work.</p>
<p>sculpture</p>	<p>Sculpture, is an artistic form in which hard or plastic materials are worked into three-dimensional art objects.</p>
<p>texture</p>	<p>Clay tools and found objects can be used to add texture to clay</p>
