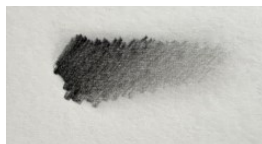

Glossary

blending



Using your finger to smooth out and create soft gradual changes between tones.

hatching



Using parallel lines. Closer lines create darker tones and lines that are further apart create lighter tones.

realism



When an artist draws things with correct proportions and the artwork looks real.

stippling



Creating tone using dots. More dots in an area create a darker tone and fewer dots a lighter tone.

tonal contrast



The difference between light and dark tones in a piece of artwork.
