<h3>Glossary</h3>	
<p>abstract art</p>	<p>The common characteristics of abstract expressionist works include large canvases, bold gestural brushstrokes, geometric abstraction, and a focus on the physical process of creating art. This style of art often features layers of paint and other materials, creating a sense of depth and texture.</p>
<p>Patrick Heron</p>	<p>Patrick Heron CBE was a British abstract and figurative artist, who lived in Zennor, Cornwall. Heron was recognised as one of the leading painters of his generation. (30 January 1920 -20 March 1999)</p>
<p>sculpture</p>	<p>sculpture, is an artistic form in which hard or plastic materials are worked into three-dimensional art objects.</p>
<p>wax batik</p>	<p>Batik is a wax-resist technique for producing designs and patterns on fabric. Wax is applied to the fabric with a brush, tjanting tool or stamp prior to dyeing to keep the color from reaching the fiber.</p>
<p>willow/withies</p>	<p>Willow is a wonderfully versatile medium and is perfect for making sculpture. The ability to bend and twist willow means the possibilities for designs of willow sculpture are endless. It can easily be woven into all shapes and sizes.</p>
