Dear parents and carers,

I hope you have all had a great holiday and enjoyed the sun.

We are all looking forward to welcoming the children back to school on **Tuesday 2nd September** and they will spend this day settling into their new classrooms and starting to learn new routines. The gates will open at 0840 and close at 0850 to enable registration and a prompt start to learning time. Collection time remains the same at 1525 from the bottom playground.

During the week beginning 15th September, we will be running our Meet the Teacher information sessions so you will be able to find out more about your child's new class. Dates will follow when we are back at school.

School uniform

School uniform remains the same and please ensure that every item has been named so we can easily return it if mislaid.

- Purple school sweatshirt or cardigan with or without school logo
- White polo shirt
- School fleece with or without school logo
- Black school trousers (black jeans are not permitted), black shorts or black skirt
- Sensible plain black shoes or plain black trainers

The only permitted jewellery that may be worn is:

- One pair of stud earrings – no other piercings
- A sensible wristwatch - no electronic smart watches

PE Kit

- Plain white T-shirt with (or without) school logo
- Black shorts
- Suitable trainers or other sports footwear, e.g. football boots, plimsolls

PE days will be shared with you by the end of the first week.

Teambuilding Day

On **Thursday 4th September**, we have an exciting teambuilding day planned again!

Children in Reception, Year 1, Year 2 and Year 3 will be based at school and take part in team building games and other activities including archery, an obstacle course, kinball and ultimate dodgeball, run by DT Coaching. We ask that children wear their PE kit to school on this day and bring their water bottle and a waterproof jacket in case of rain, or a sun hat and sun cream if it's sunny.

these year groups come to the top playground gate on this day and children will be registered on the playground. We will return before the end of the school day. Children can wear their own clothes suitable for the beach. Wetsuits will be provided.

Children will need to bring:
